Part 1 Details

The family of SFC Wayne K. Carlton has invited the Patriot Guard Riders to honor the service and memory of their loved one by standing a Flag Line at his re-interment.

Riders will stage at the DFW National Cemetery Visitor's Center for a short mission briefing. Honor bikes will be selected and they will proceed to the cemetery's Administration Building for procession staging. The remaining riders will proceed to the burial location in Section 94, establish the Flag Line and await the arrival of SFC Carlton, family and friends. This is a direct re-interment and the Military Honor Guard will not be present. At the direction of the MRC, flags will be returned to the support vehicle and after a short mission debrief, we will be dismissed.

**Begin drinking water the night before. Drink water when you wake up and continue drinking water all day to ensure your body stays hydrated.**
